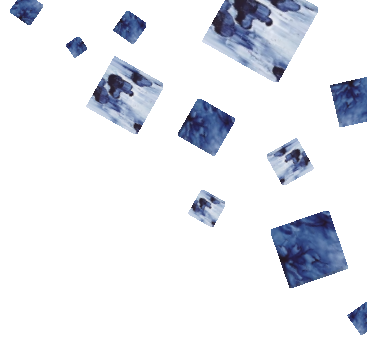
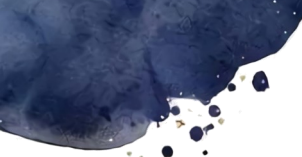
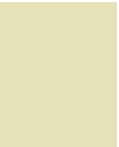

Transportation:

Taiwan Railway (TRA)

06 The Taiwan Railway calls at Tainan station. Once there, leave from the rear exit. Go down Daxue Rd. W Sec. then turn right and go down Yule St. Turn left at Minzu Rd. Sec 1 and go straight ahead.

Taiwan High-Speed Rail (THSR)

Transfer to the Taiwan Railway at the Shalun station and take the Taiwan Railway from Shalun to Tainan. The train calls at Tainan station. Once there, leave from the rear exit. Go down Daxue Rd. W Sec. then turn right and go down Yule St. Turn left at Minzu Rd. Sec 1 and go straight ahead.
