Refund policy due to COVID-19 or an unexpected national disaster in the USA that forces all visitors to leave the country:

If summer camp travel plans are affected by adverse travel restrictions and mandatory quarantine of 14 days or longer, students can choose to travel to the USA the next summer. MCI may provide online programming as an alternative if students are unable to travel to the U.S. In either case, students will be offered opportunities to meet graduation requirements, and no refund will be provided.

As an exception, Grade 11 students whose summer camp travel plans are affected by adverse travel restrictions and mandatory quarantine of 14 days or longer due to COVID-19, are allowed to defer participation in the summer program in the USA to after the completion of Grade 12. Online programming may be provided as an alternative if the student is unable to travel the following year. MCI will assist these students with the U.S. college application process by providing recommendation letters and proof of graduation from MCI.

IMPORTANT: The option to defer participation in the summer camp until after the completion of Grade 12 will not be offered if the COVID-19 emergency and the corresponding travel restrictions are no longer in effect. In the absence of extraordinary pandemic-related circumstances, students are required to participate in the summer program in the USA at some point between the completion of Grade 9 and before entering Grade 12.
